

SketchBot Software v3.1 Release Notes

Software capabilities include:

- Built for Rotrics' faster bots (Specially engineered with Picture Mosaics)
- Support for Windows 10 and 11
- Ability to transform a portrait photo to a sketch and send to a open (non-busy) SketchBot
- SketchBots dance when not drawing
- Hot folder support for any capture device (DSLR camera, photo booth, etc)
- SketchBot iPad booth software (basic), modes include: photographer mode or selfie mode
- Ability to requeue photos to be re-sketched
- Ability to take SketchBots offline (ie. to swap a pen)
- All software comes with a base and platform with ability to purchase more

Additional add-ons:

Bottom branding sketching:

\$500 to \$900 - Our designers and developers have to spend a few days working with the logo or branding for feasibility, speed, and correct sketching. It is advisable to simply have branding pre-printed on the footer section of the 4x6 print.

Branded email take-aways. This included in this version the software, however the output can easily be fed into any social sharing software (Snappic, Mediashare, etc). We are currently working on an online portal that would allow this configuration as it has to happen outside the software.

Notes regarding the platform:

The platform includes a nano-suction surface that can be cleaned with basic soap and water. Over time, this surface will eventually need to be replaced. This can easily be done at your location with [this product](#).

Paper recommendation:

Most media will work great outside of DNP paper (DNP paper has smudging issues with most markers). Pre-printed media from Vistaprint or purchasing this [canon photo paper are great options](#).

Marker recommendation:

Most markers will work just fine. Finding the width (of the tip) of the marker that you feel gives the look you desire will ultimately make your decision. We like 0.7mm to 1.0mm markers, but you can go with less or more. Felt tip markers work best, but moreover, ensuring that the marker and paper combination work well together and is fast drying. Stopping by your local craft store and picking up a few that you like is recommended.
